Principles

The Vitol Power International Generation Health and Safety Policy defines the framework for the Safety Management System (SMS) by setting out the Principles and Practices to be adopted by all personnel working for the company. The SMS addresses the requirements of the BS ISO 45001 standard and is subject to a continuous improvement process.

- We are committed to achieving the best Health and Safety Performance.
- We will comply with all legal requirements and all other appropriate standards.
- To eliminate hazards and reduce health and safety risks we will provide a safe working environment, allow time to work safely, provide suitable resources, procedures and the required training to ensure employee competency.
- We will work with our Contractors and engage with them using their competent employees.
- That everybody is responsible for their own safety, the safety of others and for adherence to all procedures.
- Providing measurable objectives and targets to drive continual improvement in Health & Safety.
- We will maintain an ongoing and open dialogue with all employees, contractors and customers, appropriately responding to all health & safety concerns.

Practice

We shall always:

- Operate equipment within approved control limits and with safety devices in service.
- Stop, seek assistance and involve others whenever we are unsure.
- Take time to appropriately assess risks before starting work, stop if work changes and reassess risks before continuing.
- Perform work with due consideration for others.
- Intervene and STOP unsafe work, whether directly involved or not.
- Report all injuries, incidents and near misses immediately.
- Prevent site virus transmission by observing our established pandemic procedures.
